



Admission Safety Induction

COURSE: NR-34 – ADMISSION SAFETY INDUCTION

SCOPE AND APPLICABILITY:

The NR-34 Onboard Safety Induction course is designed to enhance the safety of workers and protect the environment. Completion of this course verifies that personnel have met basic regulatory and company specific safety requirements to begin working offshore.

REGULATIONS & STANDARDS:

- NR-34 - Working Conditions and Environment in the Shipbuilding and Repair Industry;
- NR-30 - Regulatory Standard for Safety and Health in Waterway Work.

COURSE CONTENT:

1. The risks inherent to the activity (all the activities that are usually held);
2. The conditions and the working environment;
3. Collective Protection Equipment - existing EPC in the establishment;
4. The proper use of Personal Protective Equipment - PPE.

COURSE DESIGN:

6 Hours – First time;
4 hours – Refresh.

PREREQUISITE(S):

The training must be done during normal period of work. In case of refresh, it is necessary to present the first certificate.

MINIMUM/MAXIMUM NUMBER OF DELEGATES

This course requires a minimum of 1, and a maximum number of 12 trainees.
To offshore trainings, the course number of attendees will comply with the vessels/rig necessity.

CERTIFICATION:

Certificate of training

CERTIFICATE VALIDITY PERIOD:

1 Year; or When the worker is away from the position for more than 90 days; or If there has been a fatal accident in the workplace.
